### **Tossed Nature Quilt**

#### **Materials**

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

1/4 yard 1027-60 Timeless Linen Basics - Lt. Green
1/4 yard 1027-111 Timeless Linen Basics - Soft Blue
1/4 yard 1027-202 Timeless Linen Basics - Dk. Pink
1/3 yard 1607-99B Chrysanthemum - Black
1/3 yard 1615-99B Fern - Black
3/8 yard 1621-99B Sunflower - Black
5/8 yard 7755-22 Folio Basics - Peach
1/8 yards 1623-99 Appliqué Shapes - Multi
35/8 yards 1620-99B Drawn Flowers - Black for backing
64" x 64" piece of batting

#### **Cut Fabrics**

Note: All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise indicated.

From 1027-60 Timeless Linen Basics - Lt. Green, cut:  $*(4) 1\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips for border 2.

## From 1027-111 Timeless Linen Basics - Soft Blue, cut:

\*(5)  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips for border 4.

# From 1027-202 Timeless Linen Basics - Dk. Pink, cut:

\*(5)  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips for border 6.

#### From 1607-99B Chrysanthemum - Black, cut:

\*(4) 2" x WOF strips for border 1.

#### From 1615-99B Fern - Black, cut:

\*(4) 2" x WOF strips for border 3.

#### From 1621-99B Sunflower - Black, cut:

\*(5) 2" x WOF strips for border 5.

#### From 7755-22 Folio Basics - Peach, cut:

\*(6)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for binding.

#### From 1623-99 Appliqué Shapes - Multi, cut:

\*(1) 33" x 33" square.

\*(6) 5" x WOF strips for border 7.

#### From 1620-99B Drawn Flowers - Black, cut:

\*(2) 63" x WOF strips, pieced horizontally.

#### **Assemble Quilt Top**


- 1. For border 1, trim (2) 2" 1607-99B Chrysanthemum Black strips to 33" length. Sew one strip to each side of the 33" 1623-99 Appliqué Shapes Multi square and press the seams toward the border strips. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut 2 border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.
- 2. For border 2, measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and trim (2) 1½" 1027-60 Timeless Linen Basics Lt. Green strips that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top and press the seams toward the border strips. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut 2 border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.
- 3. Repeat Step 2 with the (4) 2" 1615-99B Fern Black strips to add border 3.
- 4. Repeat Step 2 with the (5)  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " 1027-111 Timeless Linen Basics Soft Blue strips to add border 4.
- 5. For border 5, join the (5) 2" 1621-99B Sunflower Black strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and cut two border strips that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top and press the seams toward the border strips. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut 2 border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.
- 6. Repeat Step 5 with the (5) 11/4" 1027-202 Timeless Linen Basics Dk. Pink strips to make and add border 6.
- 7. Repeat Step 5 with the (6) 5" 1623-99 Appliqué Shapes Multi strips to make and add border 7.

#### **Finishing**

8. Create a quilt sandwich with the batting between the quilt top and the backing. Pin or baste the layers together, mark quilting design, and quilt by

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- hand or machine. When quilting is complete, remove pins or basting, and trim batting and backing even with raw edges of the quilt top.
- 9. Join the (6) 2½" 7755-22 Folio Basics Peach binding strips together end to end using a diagonal seam to make one long strip. With wrong sides facing, fold in half lengthwise and press. Sew the binding to the edges of the quilt, mitering corners, and overlapping ends. Fold the binding to the back of the quilt and stitch it in place by hand to finish.
