Twist Quilt

MATERIALS

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

1/8 yard 1027-32 Timeless Linen Basics - Orange
 1/3 yard 1611-99B Cat and Mouse - Black
 5/8 yard 1027-75 Timeless Linen Basics - Slate Blue
 5/8 yard 1621-99B Sunflowers - Black
 3/4 yard 1027-111 Timeless Linen Basics - Soft Blue
 1 yard 1027-22 Timeless Linen Basics - Lt. Pink
 1 yard 1027-44 Timeless Linen Basics - Cream
 1 yard 1623-99 Appliqué Shapes - Multi
 1 2/3 yards 7755-01W Folio Basics - White
 3 5/8 yards 1617-99B Snowflakes - Black for backing
 64" x 75" piece of batting

CUTTING

Note: All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise indicated.

From 1027-32 Timeless Linen Basics – Orange, cut:

*(1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 1 1/2" squares.

From 1611-99B Cat and Mouse – Black, cut:

*(5) 1 1/2" x WOF strips for border 2.

From 1027-75 Timeless Linen Basics - Slate Blue, cut:

*(6) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (120) 2" squares.

*(2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 2 1/2" squares.

From 1621-99B Sunflowers – Black, cut:

*(7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From 1027-111 Timeless Linen Basics - Soft Blue, cut:

*(2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 2" squares.

*(2) 4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 2" x 4" rectangles.

*(2) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 2" x 5 1/2" rectangles.

From each, cut:

1027-22 Timeless Linen Basics - Lt. Pink

1027-44 Timeless Linen Basics – Cream

*(2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 2" squares.

*(3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 2 1/2" squares.

*(5) 4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut:

- (40) 2 1/2" x 4" rectangles.

- (40) 2" x 4" rectangles.

From 1623-99 Appliqué Shapes - Multi, cut:

*(6) 5" x WOF strips for border 3.

From 7755-01W Folio Basics – White, cut:

*(1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" sashing rectangles.

*(9) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (189) 2" squares.

*(2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut:

- (20) 2 1/2" squares.

- (11) 2" squares, for a total of 200.

*(4) 4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) 2" x 4" rectangles.

*(1) 10 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (28) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" sashing rectangles, for a total of 31.

*(5) 1 1/2" x WOF strips for border 1.

From 1617-99B Snowflakes - Black, cut:

*(2) 64" x WOF panels, pieced horizontally.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Note: Steps 2 – 6 use the *Stitch and Flip* technique, where you stitch squares to rectangles, trim the seam allowances to 1/4", and press open.

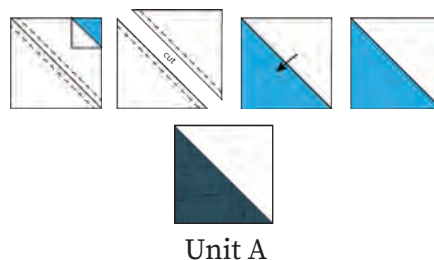
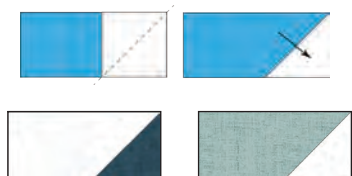


Figure 1 – Make (40) 2" units.

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 2 1/2" 7755-01W Folio Basics – White squares. With right sides together, layer a marked White square atop a 2 1/2" 1027-75 Timeless Linen Basics - Slate Blue square. Stitch 1/4" from each side of the diagonal line, cut on the drawn line, press each unit open with seams toward the darker fabric, and trim dog ears (*Figure 1*). Repeat with all the squares and trim the units to 2". Make 40 half-square triangles.

2. Mark (20) 2" Timeless Linen Basics - Slate Blue squares as in Step 1. Noting stitching line orientation, sew a Slate Blue square to the right side of a 2" x 4" Folio Basics – White rectangle. Trim the seam allowance to 1/4" and press open. Repeat to make (40) 2" x 4" units.
 - Repeat this step with the (40) 2" x 4"

1027-111 Timeless Linen Basics - Soft Blue rectangles and (40) 2" Folio Basics - White squares to make (40) 2" x 4" units (Figure 2).



Unit B Unit C

Figure 2 - Make 40 of each type.

- Repeat Step 2 with the remaining 2" x 4" Folio Basics - White rectangles and the 2" 1027-44 Timeless Linen Basics - Cream squares to make (40) 2" x 4" units (Figure 3). Note the stitching line direction!



Unit D

Figure 3 - Make (40) 2" x 4" units.

- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 2" Timeless Linen Basics - Slate Blue squares. With right sides together, place one marked Slate Blue square on the right side of a 2" x 4" 1027-22 Timeless Linen Basics - Lt. Pink rectangle and stitch on the drawn line (notice the direction of the stitching line). Trim the seam allowance to 1/4" and press open. Sew a 2" Timeless Linen Basics - Soft Blue square to the left side of the same rectangle. Trim as before and press open. Repeat to make (40) 2" x 4" units.
 - Repeat this step with (40) 2" x 4" Timeless Linen Basics - Cream rectangles and (80) 2" Folio Basics - White squares to make (40) 2" x 4" units (Figure 4).

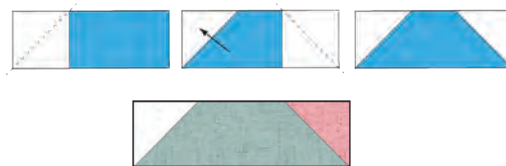


Unit E Unit F

Figure 4 - Make 40 of each type.

- Repeat Step 4 with the (40) 2" x 5 1/2" Timeless Linen Basics - Soft Blue rectangles, (40) 2" Folio Basics - White squares, and (40) 2" Timeless Linen Basics - Lt. Pink squares

to make (40) 2" x 5 1/2" units (Figure 5). Note stitching line direction!



Unit G

Figure 5 - Make (40) 2" x 5 1/2" units.

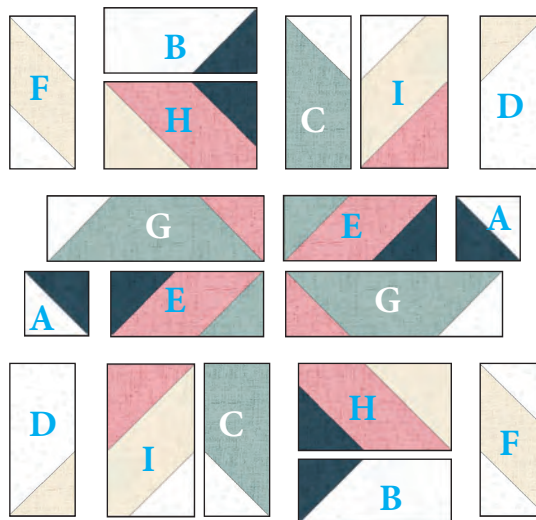
- Using the same Stitch and Flip technique, mark and sew a 2" Slate Blue square to the top right corner of a 2 1/2" x 4" Lt. Pink rectangle and a 2 1/2" Timeless Linen Basics - Cream square to the left side. Note the stitching line orientation! Repeat to make (40) 2 1/2" x 4" units.
 - Repeat this step with the remaining (40) 2" Folio White squares, the 2 1/2" x 4" Cream rectangles, and the 2 1/2" Lt. Pink squares to make (40) 2 1/2" x 4" units (Figure 6).



Unit H Unit I

Figure 6 - Make 40 of each type.

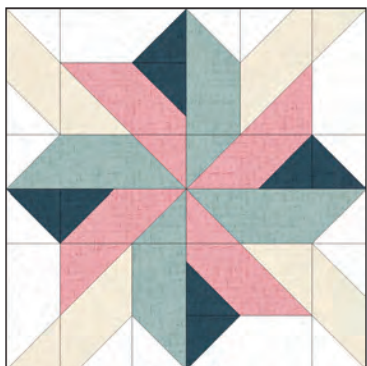


Figure 7 – Make (20) 10½” blocks.

- Arrange the Step 1 - 6 units in 3 rows as shown below. Sew the units together in each row, press the seams open, and sew the rows together to make (20) 10 1/2" blocks (Figure 7, here and next page). Press the seams in opposite directions from block to block.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

8. Referring to the quilt photo and diagram for block placement, lay out 4 blocks and (3) 1½" x 10½" Folio Basics – White sashing rectangles in 5 rows. Join the blocks and sashing rectangles together in each row. Press the seams toward the sashing.
9. To make the horizontal sashing rows, sew together 4 White sashing rectangles and (3) 1½" 1027-32 Timeless Linen Basics – Orange cornerstone squares. Repeat to make 4 sashing rows. Press the seams toward the sashing.
10. Matching adjacent seams, sew the block and sashing rows together. Press the seams in one direction.
11. For border 1, sew the (5) 1½" Folio Basics - White border strips together end to end using

diagonal seams. Measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and cut two border strips that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top and press the seams away from the center. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut two border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.

12. Repeat Step 11 with the (5) 1½" 1611-99B Cat and Mouse – Black strips to make and add border 2.
13. Repeat Step 11 with the (6) 5" 1623-99 Appliqué Shapes – Multi strips to make and add border 3.

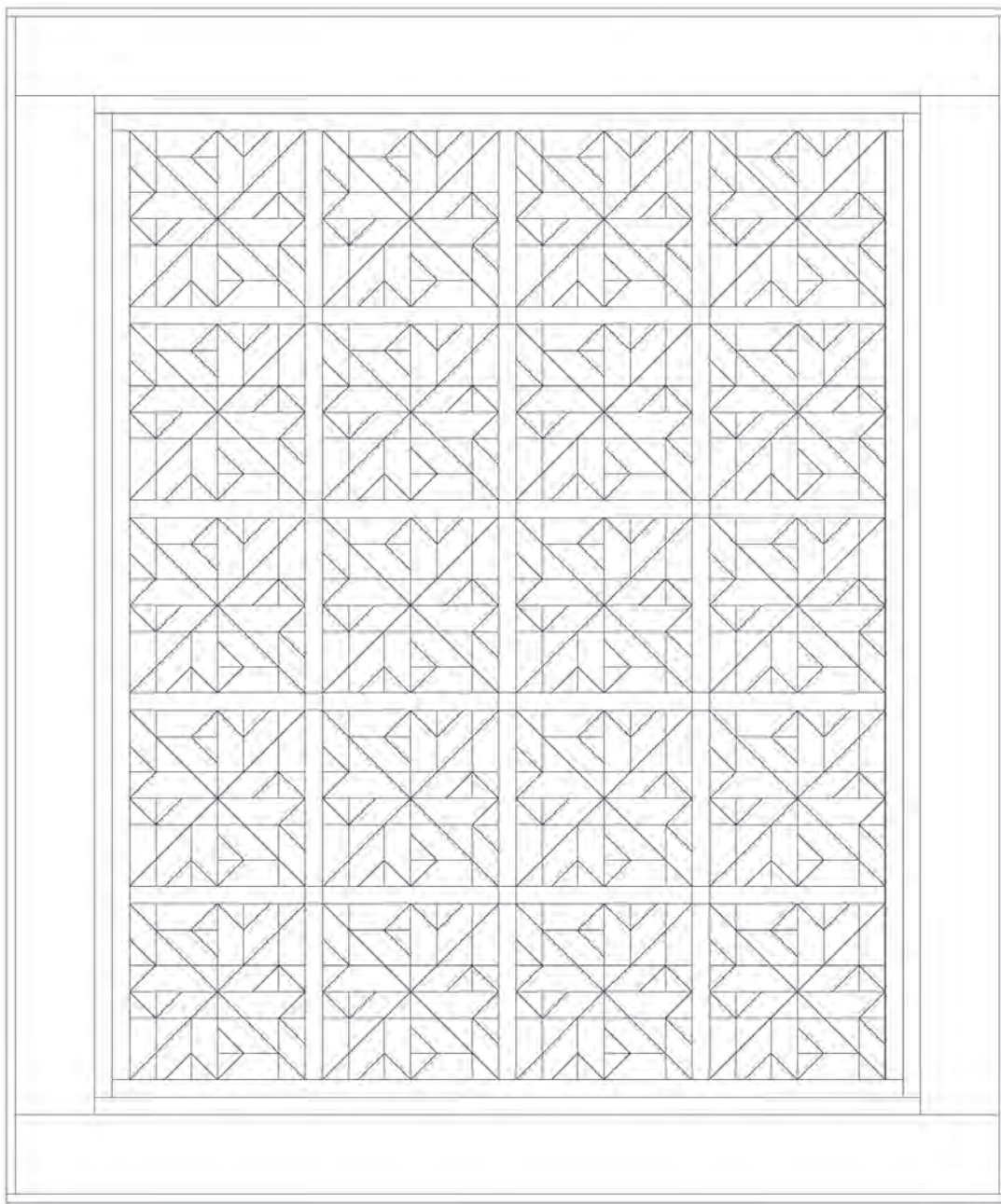
FINISHING

14. Create a quilt sandwich with the batting between the quilt top and the backing. Pin or baste layers together, mark the quilting design, and quilt by hand or machine. When the quilting is complete, remove pins or basting, and trim batting and backing even with the raw edges of the quilt top.
15. Join the (7) 2½" 1621-99B Sunflowers – Black binding strips together end to end using a diagonal seam to make one long strip. Trim the seams to ¼" and press them open. With wrong sides together, fold the strip in half lengthwise and press. Sew the binding to the edges of the quilt top, mitering corners and overlapping ends. Fold the binding to the back of the quilt and hand stitch in place.
