From the Tiny Petals 6" Repeat - Pumpkin (A), cut:

- (8) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) $11 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Asterisk Flower 8" Repeat - Heather (B), cut: -(8) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) $11 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Eucalyptus Leaves 8" Repeat - Eucalyptus (C), cut: -(8) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 81 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Peony 12" Repeat - Lilac (D), cut:

- (8) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) $11 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Timeless Linen Basics - Light Pink (E), cut:
-(3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 501 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 441 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Timeless Linen Basics - Light Green (F), cut:

- (1) $33 / 8$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $33 / 8$ " squares.

- (2) $11 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Brushstrokes - Off White (J), cut:
-(1) $33 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $33 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Tiny Petals 6" Repeat - Lavender (K), cut:
-(1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (15) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Peony 12" Repeat - Lipstick (L), cut:
- (2) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- (4) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- (5) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) $11 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.
- (8) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x $81 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Daisy and Ditsy 8 " Repeat - Cantaloupe (M), cut:

- (4) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) $11 / 2 "$ x $41 / 2 "$ strips.
- (5) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Pressed Flower Stripe 12" Repeat - Potpourri (N), cut:

- (2) $51 / 2 " \times 521 / 2 "$ Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
-(2) $51 / 2 " \times 441 / 2 "$ LOF strips.


## From the Daisy and Ditsy 8" Repeat - Dreamhouse (Backing), cut:

- (2) $62 "$ x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 62 " x 70 " back.

Block Assembly
Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew together (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 81 / 2 "$

Fabric A strip, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$
Fabric B, (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip, (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip, (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric A strip, (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " Fabric B strip, (1) $1^{1} 1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2 \prime$ " Fabric C strip and (1) $11 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make (1) $81 / 2$ " Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (15) Unit 1 squares total.

2. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ outside the drawn lines.
3. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
4. Refer to Figure 2 to arrange and press the (9) Fabric F petals and (1) Fabric E flower center onto (1) Unit 1 square.
5. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Block One square.
6. Repeat Steps 4-5 to make
(3) Block One squares total.

7. Repeat Steps 4-5 and refer to Figures 3-6 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (3) of each block square for Block Two through Block Five.

8. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 21 / 2 "$ Fabric L strip to each side of (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric K square. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric L strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric K square to make (1) $41 / 2 "$ Unit 2 square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (15) Unit 2 squares total.
9. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric M strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 square. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric M strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 square to make (1) $61 / 2$ " Unit 3 square (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (15) Unit 3 squares total.

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10. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric L strip to each side of (1) Unit 3 square. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} \times 1 \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric L strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 3 square to make (1) $81 / 2$ " Block Six square (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (15) Block Six squares total.

11. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Six square, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Six square and (1) Block Three square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 10).
12. Repeat Step 11 and refer to Figure 10 for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Two through Row Six.
13. Sew together the (6) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from the top to bottom, to make the $401 / 2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ Center Block (Fig. 10).

14. Place (1) $3 / 8 / 8$ " Fabric I square on top of (1) $33 / 8$ "

Fabric J square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 11). Sew $1 / 4$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 11). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 12) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 3 " square to make (2) Unit 4 squares (Fig. 13). Repeat to make (8) Unit 4 square total.
15. Repeat Step 14 and refer to Figure 14 for fabric identification and placement to make (8) Unit 5 squares.

16. Sew (1) Unit 4 square to the left side of (1) Unit 5 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 5 square to the left side of (1) Unit 4 square to make the bottom row. Sew the (2) rows together lengthwise to make (1) $51 / 2$ " Block Seven square (Fig. 15). Repeat to make a second Block Seven square.
17. Sew (1) Unit 5 square to the left side of (1) Unit 4 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 4 square to the left side of (1) Unit 5 square to make the bottom row. Sew the (2) rows together lengthwise to make (1) $51 / 2$ " Block Eight square (Fig. 16). Repeat to make a second Block Eight square.

## Quilt Top Assembly

 (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 18. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 48 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.19. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} \gg \times 501 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 441 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
20. Sew (1) $5 \frac{1}{2} " \times 521 / 2 "$ Fabric $N$ strip to each side of the Center Block.
21. Sew together (1) Block Seven square, (1) $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 44 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric N strip and (1) Block Eight square end to end and in that order from left to right. Sew the newly sewn strip to the top of the Center Block.
22. Sew together (1) Block Eight square, (1) $51 / 2$ " $\times 441 / 2$ " Fabric N strip and (1) Block Seven square end to end and in that order from left to right. Sew the newly sewn strip to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
23. Layer and quilt as desired.
24. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
25. Bind as desired.
