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Materials

3/4 yard (0.69m)	Stripe - Multi Pastel (A)	3418-12
1 yard (0.91m)	Packed Floral - Light Blue (B)	3413-17
² / ₃ yard (0.61m)	Packed Allover Leaf - Pink (C)	3414-22*
³ / ₄ yard (0.69m)	Floral and Lace - Blue (D)	3410-77
3 yards (2.74m)	Paisleys - Light Blue (Backing)	3415-17

^{*}Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Stripe - Multi Pastel (A), cut:

• (6) 4" x 43" WOF strips.

From the Packed Floral - Light Blue (B), cut:

• (7) 3" x 43" WOF strips.

From the Packed Allover Leaf - Pink (C), cut:

- (2) 1 1/4" x 43" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ¹/₄" x 40 ¹/₂" WOF strips.
- (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Floral and Lace - Blue (D), cut:

- (3) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 ½" x 44 ½" strips.
- (3) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 ½" x 46 ½" strips.

From the Paisleys - Light Blue (Backing), cut:

• (2) 54" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 54" x 58" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew together lengthwise (7) 3" x 43" Fabric B strips and (6) 4" x 43" Fabric A strips, alternating them from left to right, to make the 39" x 43" Center Block (Fig. 1).




Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
2. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 43" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block.

- 3. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 46 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 4. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 5. Sew the (5) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 6. Bind as desired.



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
