

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 36" Old Glory Panel - Multi (A), fussy cut:

- (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle centered on the flower (A-1).
- (1) 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square centered on the bell (A-2).
- (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 15" rectangle centered on "Old Glory" (A-3).
- (1) 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square centered on the eagle (A-4).
- (1) $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " square centered on the flowers (A-5).
- (1) 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square centered on the stars (A-6).
- (1) 8" x 8" square centered on the hat (A-7).

• (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle centered on the dove (A-8).

From the Paisley - Multi (B), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 3" x 11 ¹/₂" strips and (2) 2" x 6 ¹/₂" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 11 ¹/₂" strips and (2) 2" x 8 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Vines - Multi (C), cut:

- (1) 2 ¹/₄" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 ¹/₄" x 11 ¹/₂" strips and (2) 2 ¹/₄" x 8" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 11 ¹/₂" strips and (2) 2" x 8 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Dashes - Multi (D), cut:

- (1) 2 ³/₄" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 ³/₄" x 6 ¹/₂" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 19 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Floral Vine - Navy (E), cut:

- (1) 6 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6 ¹/₂" squares.
- From the remaining fabric cut (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 20 ¹/₂" strips and (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 8 ¹/₂" strips, piece as needed.

From the Vines and Small Floral - Multi (F), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 3" x 11 ¹/₂" strips and (2) 2" x 6 ¹/₂" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 11 ¹/₂" strips and (2) 2" x 8 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Texture - Red (G), cut:

• (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 11 ¹/₂" strips and (2) 2" x 8 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Roses - Red (H), cut:

• (1) 6 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 6 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Wallpaper Stripe - Navy (I), cut:

- (4) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (14) 1 ¹/₂" x 8 ¹/₂" strips.
- (3) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (14) 1 ¹/₂" x 6 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Dominos - Red (J), cut:

(4) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (14) 1 ¹/₂" x 10 ¹/₂" strips.
(4) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (14) 1 ¹/₂" x 8 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Floral Vine - Gold (K), cut:

• (1) 6 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Dotted Rectangles - Green on Cream (L), cut:

- (3) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 48 ¹/₂" strips.
- (3) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 46 ¹/₂" strips.
- (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 42 ¹/₂" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 40 ¹/₂" WOF strips.

From the Small Geometric - Red (M), cut:

• (3) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (44) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Small Geometric - Navy (N), cut:

- (3) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (44) 2 ¹/₂" squares.
- (6) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Wall Paper Stripe - Red (O), cut:

• (6) 3 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 3 ¹/₂" x 58" strips.

From the Paisley - Multi (Backing), cut:


• (2) 62" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 62" x 62" back.


Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.


1. Sew (1) 2" x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A-1 rectangle. Sew (1) 3" x 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A-1 rectangle to make the Block One square (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 10 \frac{1}{2}" x 10 \frac{1}{2}".**




2. Sew (1) 2" x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A-2 square. Sew (1) 2" x 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the A-2 square to make the Block Two square (Fig. 2). Trim the block to measure 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".




3. Sew (1) 2 ³/₄" x 6 ¹/₂" Fabric D strip to each side of the 15" x 6 ¹/₂" Fabric A-3 rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 19 ¹/₂" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A-3 rectangle to make the Unit 1 rectangle (Fig. 3). **Trim the unit to measure 18** ¹/₂" x 8 ¹/₂".




4. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to each side of the Unit 1 rectangle. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 rectangle to make the 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Three rectangle (Fig. 4).




5. Sew (1) 2" x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A-4 square. Sew (1) 2" x 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the A-4 square to make the Block Four square (Fig. 5). Trim the block to measure 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".



6. Sew (1) 2" x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to each side of the 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A-5 square. Sew (1) 2" x 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the A-5 square to make the Block Five square (Fig. 6). Trim the block to measure 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".




7. Sew (1) 2" x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to each side of the 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A-6 square. Sew (1) 2" x 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the A-6 square to make the Block Six square (Fig. 7). Trim the block to measure 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".




8. Sew (1) 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 8" Fabric C strip to each side of the 8" Fabric A-7 square. Sew (1) 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the A-7 square to make the Block Seven square (Fig. 8). **Trim the block to measure 10** $\frac{1}{2}$ " x **10** $\frac{1}{2}$ ".




9. Sew (1) 2" x 6 ¹/₂" Fabric F strip to each side of the 8 ¹/₂" x 6 ¹/₂" Fabric A-8 rectangle. Sew (1) 3" x 11 ¹/₂" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the A-8 rectangle to make the Block Eight square (Fig. 9). **Trim the block to measure 10 ¹/₂" x 10 ¹/₂".**



10. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to each side of (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H square. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric H square to make (1) 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 2 square (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (3) Unit 2 squares total.



11. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to each side of (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E square. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric E square to make (1) 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 3 square (Fig. 11). Repeat to make a second Unit 3 square.



12. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to each side of (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K square. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric K square to make (1) 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 4 square (Fig. 12). Repeat to make a second Unit 4 square.

13. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 square. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip to the top and bottom of the Unit 2 square to make (1) $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Nine square (Fig. 13). Repeat to make (3) Block Nine squares total.




14. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip to each side of (1) Unit 3 square. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip to the top and bottom of the Unit 3 square to make (1) $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Ten square (Fig. 14). Repeat to make a second Block Ten square.

15. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip to each side of (1) Unit 4 square. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip to the top and bottom of the Unit 4 square to make (1) 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Eleven square (Fig. 15). Repeat to make a second Block Eleven square.



16. Follow Figure 16 for block identification and placement to sew together the (15) pieced blocks into (4) rows. Sew together the (4) rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Center Block.



17. Sew together (11) 2 ¹/₂" Fabric N Side Border squares and (10) 2 ¹/₂" Fabric M squares, make 2 alternating them from the top to the Ν bottom, to make (1) Side Border (Fig. 17). Μ Repeat to make a second Side Border.

18. Sew together (12) 2 ¹/₂" Fabric M squares and (11) 2¹/₂" Fabric N squares, alternating them from left to right, to make the Top Border (Fig. 18). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 19. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric L strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ¹/₂" x 42 ¹/₂" Fabric L strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

20. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block.


21. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

22. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric L strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ¹/₂" x 48 ¹/₂" Fabric L strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

23. Center (1) 3 ¹/₂" x 58" Fabric O strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the top edge of the block and stop a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.

24. Repeat Step 23 to sew (1) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 58" Fabric O strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 19).

25. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 19), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a ¹/₄" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the quilt top.



26. Layer and quilt as desired.

27. Sew the (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric N strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

28. Bind as desired.



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
