Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 36" Old Glory Panel - Multi (A):

• Fussy cut (1) $30 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $42 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Vines and Small Floral - Multi (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 42 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 2" x 33 ½" WOF strips.

From the Small Geometric - Navy (C), cut:

- (2) 4 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (14) 4 1/8" squares.
- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) 2 ½" squares.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Small Geometric - Red (D), cut:

- (2) 4 \%" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (14) 4 \%" squares.
- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) 2 ½" squares.

From the Dashes - Multi (E), cut:

- (2) 4 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (14) 4 1/8" squares.
- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) 2 ½" squares.

From the Ditsy - Red and Cream (F), cut:

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 52 ½" strips.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Floral Vine - Navy (G), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 54 ½" strips.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 46 ½" strips.

From the Paisley - Multi (H), cut:

- (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 58 ½" strips.
- (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 54 ½" strips.


From the Vines - Multi (Backing), cut:

• (2) 62" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 62" x 74" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.


1. Sew (1) 2" x 42 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 30 ½" x 42 ½" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 33 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure 32 ½" x 44 ½".



2. Place (1) 4 %" Fabric C square on top of (1) 4 %" Fabric D square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 2). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 3) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 4 ½" square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (14) Unit 1 squares total.







3. Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figures 5-6 for fabric identification and placement to make (14) Unit 2 squares and (14) Unit 3 squares.

4. Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square on the bottom left corner of (1) Unit 1 square, right sides together (Fig. 7). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 7). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn seam (Fig. 8).





- 5. Follow Figure 9 for the seam direction to add a 2 ½" Fabric E square to the upper right corner of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 10).
- 6. Repeat Steps 4-5 to make (14) Block One squares total.

7. Repeat Steps 4-5 and refer to Figures 11-12 for component identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (14) Block Two squares and (14) Block Three squares.

8. Follow Figure 13 and sew together (4) Block One squares, (4) Block Two squares and (3) Block Three squares to make (1) Side Border. Repeat to make a second Side Border.



9. Follow Figure 14 and sew (4) Block Three squares, (3) Block Two squares and (3) Block One squares together to make the Top Border. Repeat to make the Bottom Border.



Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 10. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block.

- 11. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 12. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 52 ½" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 42 ½" Fabric F strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block.
- 13. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 54 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 46 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block.
- 14. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 58 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 54 ½" Fabric H strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 15. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 16. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 17. Bind as desired.



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
