

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Puppies - White (A), cut:

• (1) 22 ½" x 10 ½" WOF strip.

From the Paw Prints - Black (B), cut:

- (4) 1 ³/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 1 ³/₄" x 9 ¹/₂" strips.
- (6) 1 ³/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 1 ³/₄" x 12" strips.
- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 1 ½" x 24 ½" strip and (1) 1½" x 10 ½" strip.
- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 1 ½" x 24 ½" strip and (1) 1½" x 10 ½" strip.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Modern Melody Basics - White (C), cut:

- (6) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 1 1/4" x 11" strips.
- (6) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 1 1/4" x 12 1/2" strips.

From the Blocks Panel - Black (D):

• Fussy cut (8) 9 ½" squares, centered on blocks.

From the Photo Prints - Aqua (E), cut:

- (2) 4" x 36 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 4" x 24 ½" WOF strips.

From the Border Stripe - White (F), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" x 36 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 5 ½" x 24 ½" LOF strips.

From the Accessories - White (G), cut:

- (2) 3" x 36 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 3" x 24 ½" WOF strips.

From the Bones - Black (H), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 60 ½" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 51 ½" strips.

From the Tossed Puppies - Aqua (I), cut:

- (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 63 ½" strips.
- (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 61 ½" strips.

From the Words - Black (J), cut:

- (2) 1 ½" x 36 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 24 ½" WOF strips.


From the Newspaper - White (Backing), cut:

• (2) 69" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 69" x 81" back.


Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 1 ¾" x 9 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 9 ½" Fabric D square. Sew (1) 1 ¾" x 12" Fabric B strip to each side of the Fabric D square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). **Trim the unit to measure 11" x 11".** Repeat to make (8) Unit 1 squares total.




2. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 11" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 12 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) 12 ½" Block One square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (8) Block One squares total




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
3. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strip. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A strip to make the 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Two rectangle (Fig. 3).




4. Sew together (2) Block One squares. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) newly sewn strip to the top and bottom of the Block Two rectangle to make the 24 ½" x 36 ½" Center Block (Fig. 4).




- 5. Sew together (1) 3" x 36 ½" Fabric G strip, (1) 1 ½" x 36 ½" Fabric J strip, (1) 5 ½" x 36 ½" Fabric F strip and (1) 4" x 36 ½" Fabric E strip, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make the 12 ½" x 36 ½" Left Side Border (Fig. 5).
- 6. Sew together (1) 4" x 36 ½" Fabric E strip, (1) 5 ½" x 36 ½" Fabric F strip, (1) 1 ½" x 36 ½" Fabric J strip and (1) 3" x 36 ½" Fabric G strip, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make the 12 ½" x 36 ½" Right Side Border (Fig. 6).



7. Sew together (1) 3" x 24 ½" Fabric G strip, (1) 1 ½" x 24 ½" Fabric J strip, (1) 5 ½" x 24 ½" Fabric F strip and (1) 4" x 24 ½" Fabric E strip lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom. Sew (1) Block One square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border (Fig. 7).




7. Sew together (1) 4" x 24 ½" Fabric E strip, (1) 5 ½" x 24 ½" Fabric F strip, (1) 1 ½" x 24 ½" Fabric J strip and (1) 3" x 24 ½" Fabric G strip lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom. Sew (1) Block One square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Bottom Border (Fig. 8).



Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
9. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and right sides of the Center Block.

- 10. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 11. Sew (1) 2" x 60 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 51 ½" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 12. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 63 ½" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 61 ½" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 13. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 14. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 15. Bind as desired.



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
