Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Border Stripe - Green (A), cut:

• (1) 40 ½" x 24 ½" WOF strip.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Lemon (B), cut:

- (2) 1 ½" x 40 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 26 ½" WOF strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Purple (C), cut:

- (2) 1 ½" x 28 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 42 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tossed Dots - Multi (D), cut:

• (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 4 ½" squares.

From the Hearts and Flowers - Light Blue (E), cut:

• (2) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 4 ½" squares.

From the Monster Toss - Blue (F), cut:

• (2) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 4 ½" squares.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Royal (G), cut:

- (2) 1 ½" x 38 ½" WOF strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 52 ½" strips.

From the Harlequin Diamonds - Multi (H), cut:

- (3) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 ½" x 54 ½" strips.
- (3) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3½" x 44 ½" strips.


From the Monster Toss - Blue (Backing), cut:

• (2) 52" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 52" x 68" back.


Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 40 ½"
Fabric B strip to each side of the 24 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric A strip.
Sew (1) 1 ½" x 26 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A strip to make the 26 ½" x 42 ½" Center Block (Fig. 1).



- 2. Follow Figure 2 and sew together (3) 4 ½" Fabric F squares, (5) 4 ½" Fabric D squares (3) 4 ½" Fabric E squares to make the Left Side Border.
- 3. Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figures 3-5 for fabric identification and placement to make the Right Side Border, the Top Border and the Bottom Border.






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Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 4. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 42 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 28 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 5. Sew the Left Side Border and the Right Side Border to the left and right sides of the Center Block.
- 6. Sew the Top and Bottom Borders to the top and bottom of the Center Block.
- 7. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 52 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 38 ½" Fabric G strip to the and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 8. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 54 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 9. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 10. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 11. Bind as desired.
