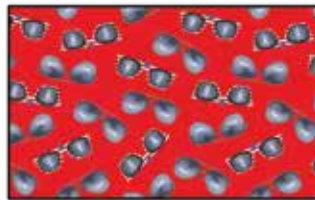

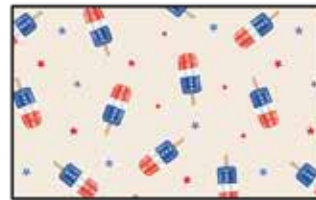

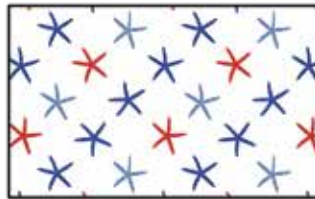

2/3 yard (0.61m)	10 x 10 Inch Blocks - Multi (A)	1810-78
1/2 yard (0.46m)	Popsicles Tossed - Cream/Multi (B)	1804-47
1/4 yard (0.23m)	Balloons - Blue/Red (C)	1799-78
1/3 yard (0.30m)	Fireworks - Blue/Red (D)	1805-78
1/2 yard (0.46m)	Sky and Clouds - Blue (E)	1801-70
1/2 yard (0.46m)	Starfish Tossed - White/Multi (F)	1807-78
1/4 yard (0.23m)	Sunglasses Tossed - Red/Blue (G)	1803-87
3/8 yard (0.34m)	Barber Stripe - Blue/Red (H)	1806-78
1 1/2 yards (1.37m)	Border Stripe - Sand/Multi (I)	1809-47
1/4 yard (0.23m)	Beach Accessories - Sand/Multi (J)	1800-47
1/2 yard (0.46m)	Folio Basics - Medium Blue (K)	7755-75*

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

### From the 10 x 10 Inch Blocks - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (6) 10 1/2" squares, (3) centered on blue blocks and (3) centered on tan blocks.

### From the Popsicles Tossed - Cream/Multi (B), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 10 1/2" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 13 1/2" strips.

### From the Balloons - Blue/Red (C), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 1/2" squares.

### From the Fireworks - Blue/Red (D), cut:

- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2 1/2" squares.

### From the Sky and Clouds - Blue (E), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" strips.
- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.
- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 1/2" squares.

### From the Starfish Tossed - White/Multi (F), cut:

- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.

### From the Sunglasses Tossed - Red/Blue (G), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 1/2" squares.

### From the Barber Stripe - Blue/Red (H), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 48 1/2" strips.
- (2) 2" x 39 1/2" WOF strips.

### From the Border Stripe - Sand/Multi (I), cut:

- (2) 6 1/2" x 51 1/2" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 6 1/2" x 39 1/2" LOF strips.

### From the Beach Accessories - Sand/Multi (J), cut:

- (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 1/2" squares.

### From the Folio Basics - Medium Blue (K), cut:

- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

### From the Beachscape - Sand/Multi (Backing), cut:

- (2) 71" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 71" x 59" back.

## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 10 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 10 1/2" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 13 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"**. Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total. Note: There will be (3) Tan Block One squares and (3) Blue Block One squares.

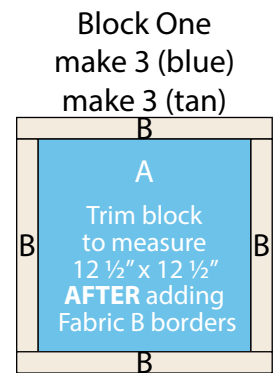

2. Place (1) 2 1/2" Fabric D square on the left side of (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric E strip (Pay attention to the orientation of the Fabric E strip), right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance (Fig. 3).

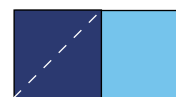

3. Place another 2 1/2" Fabric D square on the right side of the 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric E strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 5).

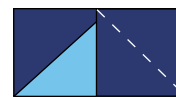

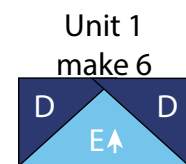

4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (6) Unit 1 strips total.

5. Repeat Steps 2-3 and refer to Figures 6-8 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (6) of each unit strip for Unit 2 through Unit 4.

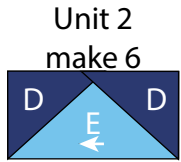

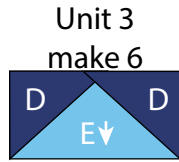

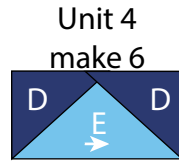

6. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric E square to each end of (1) Unit 3 square to make the top row (Fig. 9).

7. Sew together (1) Unit 2 strip, (1) 4 1/2" Fabric C square and (1) Unit 4 strip, in that order from left to right, to make the middle row (Fig. 9).

8. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric E square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the bottom row (Fig. 9).

9. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 6-8 lengthwise to make (1) 8 1/2" Unit 5 square (Fig. 9).

10. Repeat Steps 6-9 to make (6) Unit 5 squares total.

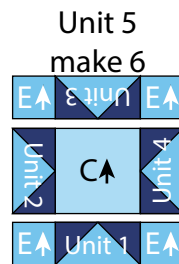

11. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric G square to each end of (1) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric F strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric F strip to each side of (1) Unit 5 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 12 1/2" Block Two square (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.

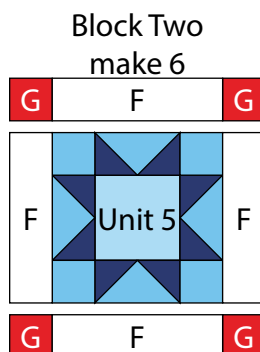

12. Sew (1) Blue Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make Row One (Fig. 11).

13. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Tan Block One square to make Row Two (Fig. 11).

14. Sew (1) Tan Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make Row Three (Fig. 11).

15. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Blue Block One square to make Row Four (Fig. 11).

16. Sew together the (4) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from the top to bottom, to make the 36 1/2" x 48 1/2" Center Block (Fig. 11).

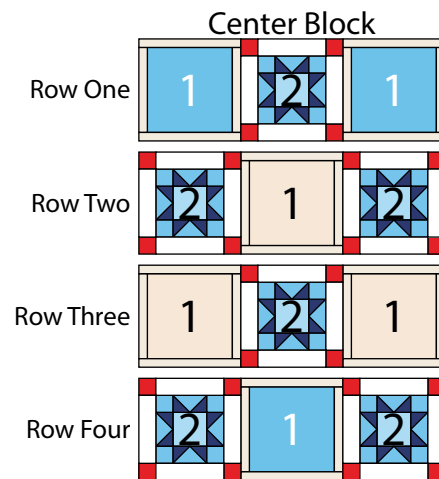

## Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

17. Sew (1) 2" x 48 1/2" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 39 1/2" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

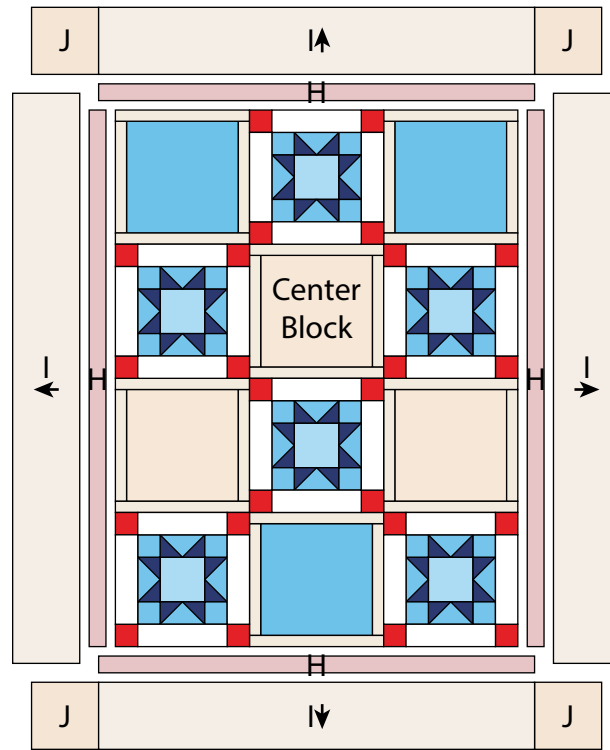
18. Sew (1) 6 1/2" x 51 1/2" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block.

19. Sew (1) 6 1/2" Fabric J square to each end of (1) 6 1/2" x 39 1/2" Fabric I strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

20. Layer and quilt as desired.

21. Sew the (6) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric K strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

22. Bind as desired.



Quilt Layout

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
