## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Banner Panel - Black (A):

- Fussy cut (1) $20 \frac{1}{2} 2 \times 421 / 2 "$ strip, centered on the panel.

From the Folio - Black (B), cut:

- (3) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 521 / 2 "$ strips.
- (8) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.
- (4) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $2 " \times 691 / 2 "$ strips.
-(4) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $2 " \times 601 / 2 "$ strips.
-(2) $11 / 2 " \times 361 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
From the Wheat Star Calico - Black (C), cut:
-(8) $37 / 8 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (75) $37 / 8 "$ squares.
- (1) $27 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) $27 / 8 "$ squares.
- (2) $3 " \times 421 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (1) $2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $2 " x 201 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Folio - Off White (D), cut:

- (6) $27 / 8 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (76) $27 / 8 "$ squares.
- (4) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 601 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 441 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Folio - Ochre (E), cut:

- (1) $37 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $37 / 8 "$ squares.
- (1) $27 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $27 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Small Novelty-Spring - Green (F), cut:

- (1) $37 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $37 / 8 "$ squares and
(2) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
-(1) $27 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $27 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Pinwheel Ombre - Cream/Gold (G), cut:
- (1) $37 / 8 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) $37 / 8 "$ squares.
-(1) $27 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) $27 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Wheat Star Calico - Green (H), cut:
- (1) $37 / 8 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $37 / 8 "$ squares.
- (1) $27 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $27 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Folio - Christmas Green (I), cut:

- (1) $37 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) $37 / 8 "$ squares.
-(1) $27 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) $27 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Small Novelty-Winter - Red (J), cut:
-(1) $37 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) $37 / 8 "$ squares and
(2) $3 \frac{1}{2} "$ squares.
- (1) $27 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $27 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Wheat Star Calico - Red (K), cut:

- (4) $7 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams cut (2) 7 " $\times 621 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $4 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4" $\times 571 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) $37 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) $37 / 8 "$ squares.
- (1) $27 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (9) $27 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Folio - Forest (L), cut:

- (1) $37 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) $37 / 8 "$ squares.
-(1) $27 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $27 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Pinwheel Ombre - Red (M), cut:
- (1) $37 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) $37 / 8 "$ squares.
- (1) $27 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) $27 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Winding Vines - Rust (N), cut:

- (1) $37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- (1) $27 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $27 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Small Novelty-Fall - Black (O), cut:

- (1) $37 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) $37 / 8 "$ squares and
(2) $3 \frac{1}{2} "$ squares.
-(1) $27 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) $27 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Small Novelty-Summer - Dark Blue (P), cut:
- (1) $37 /{ }^{7 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $37 / 8 "$ squares and
(2) $31 / 2 "$ squares.
- (1) $27 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) $27 / 8 "$ squares.


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## Cutting Instructions - Continued

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Winding Vines - Blue ( Q ), cut:

- (1) $27 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $27 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Pinwheel Ombre - Green (R), cut:
-(1) $37 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) $37 / 8 "$ squares.
-(1) $27 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $27 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Folio - Spruce (S), cut:

- (1) $37 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $37 / 8 "$ squares.
- (1) $27 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) $27 / 8 "$ squares.


## From the Folio - Gold (T), cut:

-(1) $27 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) $27 / 8 "$ squares and
(4) $2 " \times 3 "$ strips.

From the Pinwheel Ombre - Red (Backing), cut:
-(2) $86 "$ x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $74 " \times 86 "$ back.

## Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) $3 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of the $201 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x $3 "$ Fabric T strip to each end of (1) $2 " \times 201 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the $201 / 2 " \times 421 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure $24 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 441 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

2. Place (1) $27 / 8 "$ Fabric D square on top of (1) $27 / 8 "$

Fabric T square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 2). Sew $1 / 4 "$ away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 3) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $21 / 2 "$ square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (6) Unit 1 squares total.

3. Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figures 5-20 for fabric identification and placement to make the designated number of $21 / 2 "$ units for Unit 2 through Unit 17. There will be a total of (152) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

11. Follow Figure 28 below and sew together (16) assorted $21 / 2 "$ blocks together to make the Pieced Border 2-Bottom Border.
12. Place (1) $37 / 8 "$ Fabric C square on top of (1) $37 / 8$ " Fabric G square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 29). Sew $1 / 4$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 29). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 30) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 3 $1 / 2$ " square to make (2) Unit 18 squares (Fig. 31). Repeat to make (20) Unit 18 squares total.

21. Follow Figure 52 below and sew together (20) assorted $31 / 2 "$ blocks. Sew (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric J square to the left end of the new strip and (1) $31 / 2$ " Fabric O square to the right end to make the Pieced Border 3-Bottom Border.

## Quilt Top Assembly

 (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)22. Sew the Side Pieced Border 1 strips to the Center Block. Sew the Top and Bottom Pieced Border 1 strips to the Center Block.
23. Sew the Side Pieced Border 2 strips to the Center Block. Sew the Top and Bottom Pieced Border 2 strips to the Center Block.
24. Sew $21 / 2 " \times 521 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 361 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
25. Sew the Side Pieced Border 3 strips to the Center Block. Sew the Top and Bottom Pieced Border 3 strips to the Center Block.
26. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 601 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 441 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
27. Sew (1) 7 " $\times 621 / 2$ " Fabric $K$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4" x $571 / 2 "$ Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
28. Sew (1) $2 "$ x $691 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $601 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
29. Sew the Side Pieced Border 4 strips to the Center Block. Sew the Top and Bottom Pieced Border 4 strips to the Center Block to make the quilt top.
30. Layer and quilt as desired.
31. Sew the (8) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
32. Bind as desired.
