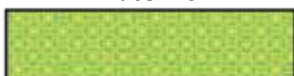

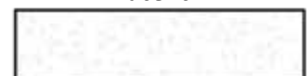

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Fun Block Panel - Pink/Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (9) 6 1/2" squares, each centered on a block.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Purple (B), cut:

- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (18) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips.
- (5) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (18) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.
- (1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1" x 14 1/2" strips.
- (1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1" x 15 1/2" strips.

From the Small Flower Toss - Pink (C), cut:

- (1) 4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 4" squares.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Orange (D), cut:

- (1) 4 3/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4 3/4" squares and (2) 4" squares. Cut the 4 3/4" square across both diagonals to make (8) 4 3/4" triangles.
- (1) 2 5/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 5/8" squares.
- (1) 2 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 1/4" squares.
- (2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1" x 14 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1" x 15 1/2" strips.

From the Folio Basics - White on White (E), cut:

- (1) 4 3/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4 3/4" squares and (4) 4 3/8" squares. Cut the 4 3/4" squares across both diagonals to make (8) 4 3/4" triangles. Cut the 4 3/8" squares across (1) diagonal to make (8) 4 3/8" triangles.
- (3) 4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 4" x 7 1/2" strips.
- (3) 4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 4" squares.
- (2) 2 5/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) 2 5/8" squares.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 1/2" x 15" strips.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 2 1/2" x 53 1/2" strips.
- (4) 2 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (60) 2 1/4" squares.
- (2) 2 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 2 1/4" x 4" strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Fuchsia (F), cut:

- (1) 4 3/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 3/8" squares and (2) 4" squares. Cut the 4 3/8" squares across (1) diagonal to make (8) 4 3/8" triangles.
- (1) 2 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 1/4" x 4" strips and (8) 2 1/4" squares.
- (2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1" x 14 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1" x 15 1/2" strips.

From the Carrot Toss - Aqua (G), cut:

- (1) 2 5/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 5/8" squares.
- (1) 2 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 1/4" squares.

From the Carrot Toss - Yellow (H), cut:

- (1) 4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 4" squares.
- (1) 4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4" x 7 1/2" strips.
- (1) 2 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 1/4" squares.
- (1) 2 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 1/4" x 4" strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - True Blue (I), cut:

- (3) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/4" x 53 1/2" strips.
- (3) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/4" x 55" strips.
- (2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1" x 14 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1" x 15 1/2" strips.
- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Small Flower Toss - Aqua (J), cut:

- (1) 4 3/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4 3/4" squares and (4) 2 1/4" squares. Cut the 4 3/4" squares across both diagonals to make (8) 4 3/4" triangles.
- (1) 2 5/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 5/8" squares.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Teal (K), cut:

- (1) 4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4" squares and (8) 2 1/4" x 4" strips.
- (1) 2 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 1/4" squares.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Lemon (L), cut:

- (1) 4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4" squares.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Lime (M), cut:

- (1) 4 3/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4 3/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (8) 4 3/4" triangles.
- (2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1" x 14 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1" x 15 1/2" strips.

From the Easter Pastel Plaid - Pink/Multi (N), cut:

- (3) 2 1/4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 1/4" x 55" strips.
- (3) 2 1/4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 1/4" x 58 1/2" strips.

From the Easter Border Stripe - Pink/Multi (O), cut:

- (4) 5 1/2" x 72" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.

From the Bunny Toss - Pink (Backing), cut:

- (2) 76" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 76" x 76" back.

Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Place (1) $2\frac{5}{8}$ " Fabric D square on top of (1) $2\frac{5}{8}$ " Fabric E square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $2\frac{1}{4}$ " square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (8) Unit 1 squares total.

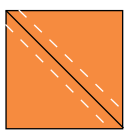

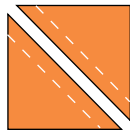

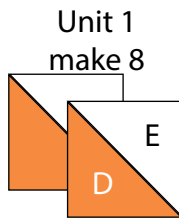

2. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric E square to the left side of (1) Unit 1 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to the left side of (1) $2\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric E square to make the bottom row. Sew the (2) newly sewn strips together lengthwise to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (4) Unit 2 squares total.

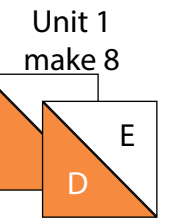

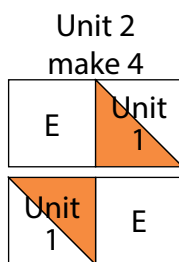

3. Place (1) 4" Fabric C square on the left side of (1) 4" x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip, right sides together (Fig. 5). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 5). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 6). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

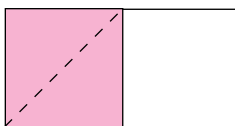

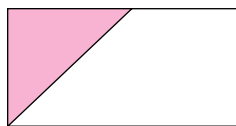

4. Place another 4" Fabric C square on the right side of the 4" x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 7). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 7). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 3 strip (Fig. 8).

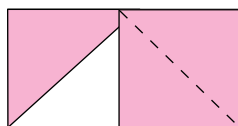

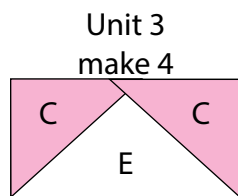

5. Repeat Steps 3-4 to make (4) Unit 3 strips total.

6. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A block. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A block. **Trim the block to measure $7\frac{1}{2}$ " square** to make (1) Unit 4 square (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (9) Unit 4 squares total.

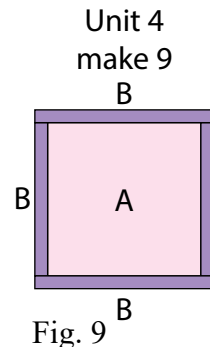

7. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to each end of (1) Unit 3 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 3 strip to each side of (1) Unit 4 square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make (1) Unit 5 square.

8. Sew (1) 1" x $14\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to each side of the Unit 5 square. Sew (1) 1" x $15\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 5 square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 11).

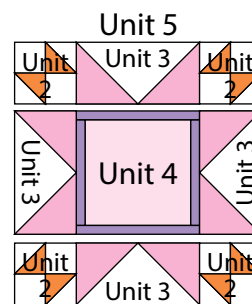

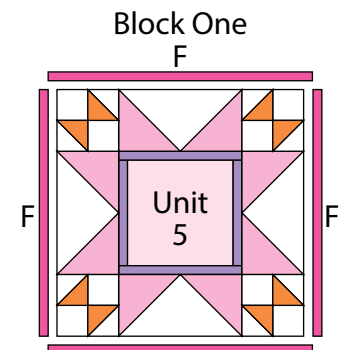

9. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 12 for fabric identification and location while using $2\frac{5}{8}$ " squares to make (16) $2\frac{1}{4}$ " Unit 6 squares.

10. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric E square to the left side of (1) Unit 6 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 6 square to the left side of (1) $2\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric G square to make the bottom row. Sew the (2) newly sewn strips together lengthwise to make (1) Unit 7 square (Fig. 13). Repeat to make (4) Unit 7 squares total.

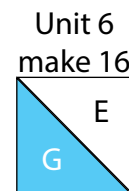

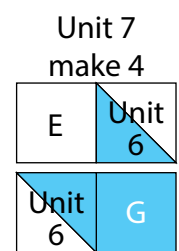

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11. Repeat Steps 3-4 and refer to Figure 14 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction while using (4) 2 1/4" x 4" Fabric E strips and (8) 2 1/4" Fabric F squares to make (4) Unit 8 strips.

12. Repeat Steps 3-4 and refer to Figure 15 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction while using (4) 2 1/4" x 4" Fabric F strips and (8) 2 1/4" Fabric E squares to make (4) Unit 9 strips.

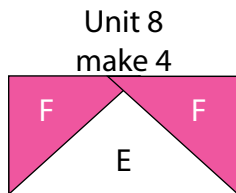

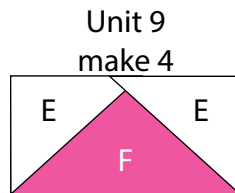

13. Sew (1) Unit 9 strip to the top of (1) Unit 8 strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 10 square (Fig. 16). Repeat to make (4) Unit 10 squares total.

14. Sew (1) Unit 6 square to the top of (1) 2 1/4" Fabric G square. Sew the newly sewn strip to the left side of (1) Unit 10 square. Sew (1) Unit 6 square to the top of (1) 2 1/4" Fabric G square. Sew the newly sewn strip to the right side of the Unit 10 square to make (1) Unit 11 strip (Fig. 17). Repeat to make (4) Unit 11 strips total.

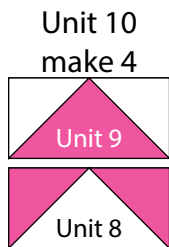

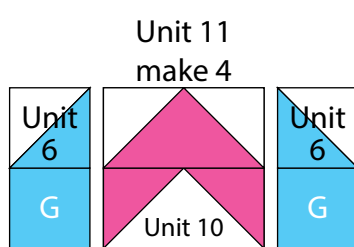

15. Sew (1) Unit 7 square to each end of (1) Unit 10 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 11 strip to each side of (1) Unit 4 square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make (1) Unit 12 square (Fig. 18).

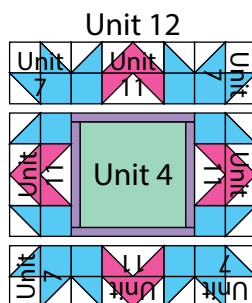

16. Sew (1) 1" x 14 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the Unit 12 square. Sew (1) 1" x 15 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 12 square to make the (1) Block Two square (Fig. 19).

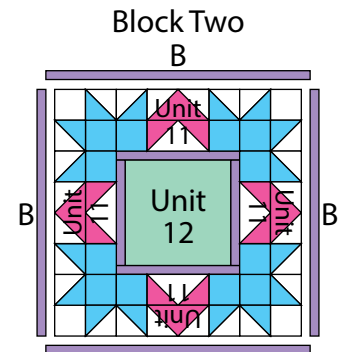

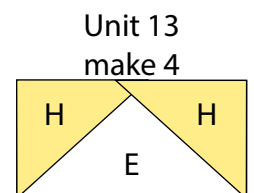

19. Sew (1) 1" x 14 1/2" Fabric I strip to each side of the Unit 14 square. Sew (1) 1" x 15 1/2" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 14 square to make (1) Block Three square (Fig. 22).

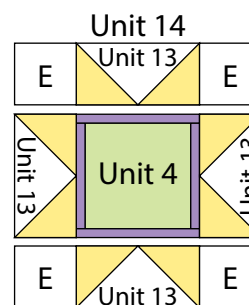

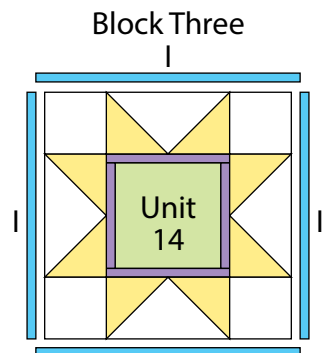

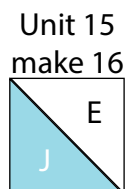

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21. Sew (1) 2 ¼" Fabric E square to the left side of (1) Unit 15 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 15 square to the left side of (1) 2 ¼" Fabric J square to make the bottom row. Sew the (2) newly sewn strips together lengthwise to make (1) Unit 16 square (Fig. 24). Repeat to make (4) Unit 16 squares total.

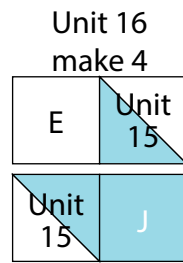

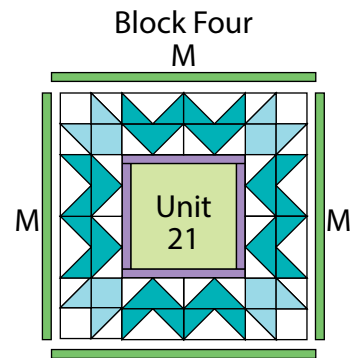

28. Sew (1) 4 ¾" Fabric D triangle and (1) 4 ¾" Fabric E triangle together along a short side. Sew (1) 4 ¾" Fabric F triangle to the long side of the newly sewn strip to make (1) Unit 22 square. The unit should measure 4" square. Repeat to make (4) Unit 22 squares total.

29. Repeat Step 28 and refer to Figure 32 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (4) Unit 23 squares.

30. Sew (1) Unit 22 square to the left side of (1) Unit 23 square along the Fabric D sides to make (1) Unit 24 strip (Fig. 33). Repeat to make (4) Unit 24 strips total.

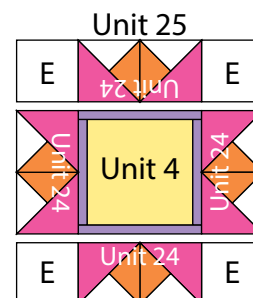

Sew the newly sewn strip to the right side of the Unit 30 square to make (1) Unit 31 strip (Fig. 41). Repeat to make (4) Unit 31 strips total.

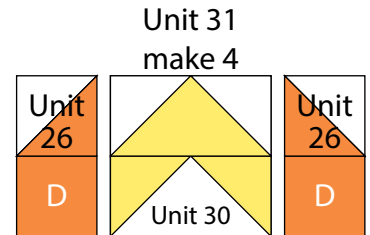

Sew (1) 4" Fabric E square to each end of the Unit 39 strip to make the bottom row. Sew the (3) rows together to make (1) Unit 40 square (Fig. 52).

48. Sew (1) 1" x 14 1/2" Fabric I strip to each side of the Unit 40 square. Sew (1) 1" x 15 1/2" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 40 square to make (1) Block Eight square (Fig. 53).

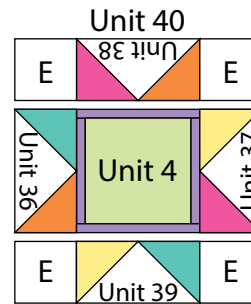

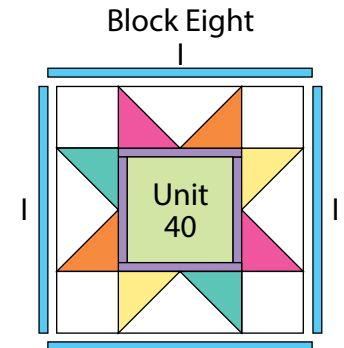

49. Sew (1) 4 3/4" Fabric M triangle and (1) 4 3/4" Fabric J triangle together along a short side. Sew (1) 4 3/8" Fabric E triangle to the long side of the newly sewn strip to make (1) Unit 41 square (Fig. 54). The square should measure 4" square. Repeat to make (4) Unit 41 squares total.

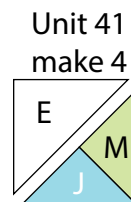

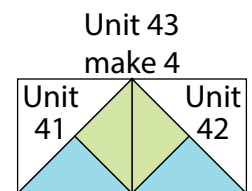

51. Sew (1) Unit 41 square to the left side of (1) Unit 42 square along the Fabric M sides to make (1) Unit 43 strip (Fig. 56). Repeat to make (4) Unit 43 strips total.

52. Sew (1) 4" Fabric E square to each end of (1) Unit 43 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 43 strip to each side of (1) Unit 4 square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make (1) Unit 44 square (Fig. 57).

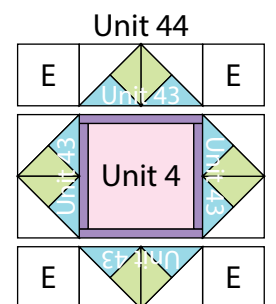
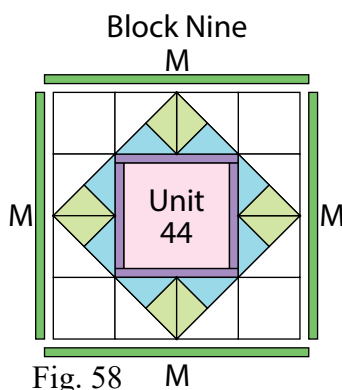

53. Sew (1) 1" x 14 1/2" Fabric M strip to each side of the Unit 44 square. Sew (1) 1" x 15 1/2" Fabric M strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 44 square to make (1) Block Nine square (Fig. 58).



Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

54. Sew together (1) 2 1/2" x 15 1/2" Fabric E strip, the Block One square, (1) 2 1/2" x 15 1/2" Fabric E strip, the Block Two square, (1) 2 1/2" x 15 1/2" Fabric E strip, the Block Three square and (1) 2 1/2" x 15 1/2" Fabric E strip, in that order from left to right, to make Row One.

55. Repeat Step 54 and refer to the Quilt Layout for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Two and Row Three.

56. Sew together (4) 2 1/2" x 53 1/2" Fabric E rows and the (3) pieced rows, in numerical order and alternating them, to make the Center Block.

57. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 53 1/2" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 55" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

58. Sew (1) 2 1/4" x 55" Fabric N strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 1/4" x 58 1/2" Fabric N strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

59. Center (1) 5 1/2" x 72" Fabric O strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a 1/4" from the top edge of the block and stop a 1/4" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.

60. Repeat Step 59 to sew (1) 5 1/2" x 72" Fabric O strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start 1/4" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 59).

61. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 59), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the quilt top.

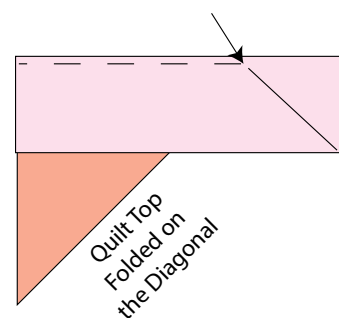
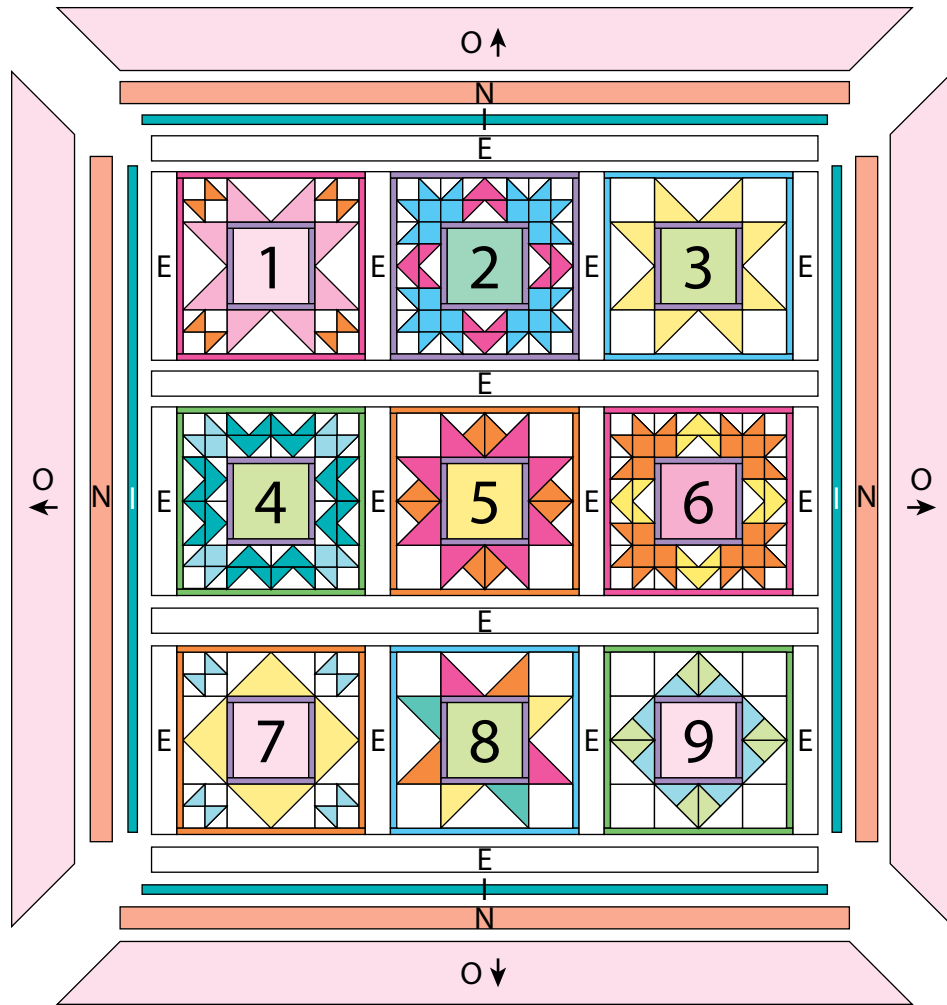

62. Layer and quilt as desired.

63. Sew the (7) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

64. Bind as desired.
