$11 / 8$ yards Plaid on Bias - Red (G)

$15 / 8$ yards Snowman Tossed Allover - Black (H) F9116-99
4 yards Words and Snowmen Tossed - Black (Backing)

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

## From the 24" Block Repeat - Black (A):

- Fussy cut (6) 10 " x $101 / 2 "$ rectangles each centered on a block.

From the Snowflake - Red (B), cut:
-(3) $2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $2 "$ x $10 \frac{1}{2} "$ strips.
-(4) $2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $2 "$ x $13 "$ strips.
From the Fluffy Solid - White (C), cut:

- (4) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 " x $121 / 2 "$ strips.
- (6) $2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $2 "$ x $151 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Snowflake - Black (D), cut:

- (2) $3 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 3" squares.

From the Chickadees on Berry Branches - Red (E), cut:
-(5) $51 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) $51 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Cardinals on Branches - Black (F), cut:

- (4) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $51 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Plaid on Bias - Red (G), cut:

- (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
- (3) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 601 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 491 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Snowman Tossed Allover - Black (H), cut:
-(4) $61 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 641 / 2 "$ strips.
-(4) $61 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $61 / 2 " \times 611 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Words and Snowmen Tossed - Black (Backing), cut:
-(2) $69 " x$ WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $69 " \times 84 "$ back.

Block Assembly
Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention fabric and unit orientation when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) $2 " \times 10 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $10 " \times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x $13 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make
(1) Unit 1 piece (Fig. 1). Trim the unit to measure
$121 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$. Repeat to make (6) Unit 1 squares total.
2. Sew (1) $2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) $2 " \times 15 \frac{1}{2} "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Unit 2 squares total.

3. Place (1) 3" Fabric D square on the top left corner of (1) Unit 2 square, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 4). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam.

4. Follow Figure 5 for the seam direction to add a $3 "$ Fabric D square to each of the remaining corners of the Unit 2 square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.

5. Sew (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric E square to each side of (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric F square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square to each side of (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric E square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.

Quilt Top Assembly
(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
6. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.
7. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Block One square to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.
8. Sew the (4) Rows together, in numerical, order to make the Center Block.
9. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 601 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 491 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) $6 \frac{1}{2} ’ \times 641 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 611 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
11. Layer and quilt as desired.
12. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
13. Bind as desired.
