Page 1

Materials

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

3/8 yard 7177-99 Mouse Plaid-Black
3/8 yard 7175-33 Birds-Yellow
3/8 yard 7177-1 Mouse Plaid-White
1/2 yard 7175-17 Birds-Blue
1/2 yard 7174-11 Black and White Cats-Sky Blue
1/2 yard 7172-33 Allover Cats-Yellow
5/8 yard 7176-99 Cat Whiskers-Black
1 yard 7170-11 Cat Blocks-Sky Blue
1 yard 7178-99 Paw Prints-Black
1-1/8 yards 7176-1 Cat Whiskers-White
2-2/3 yards 7173-17 Border Stripe-Blue
5 yards 7171-66 Cats Dreamers-Lemon Grass
80" x 90" piece of batting

Cut Fabrics

*Note: All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted. If cut across the length of the fabric (LOF), the **LOF** notation will be indicated.*

From 7177-99 Mouse Plaid-Black:

*Cut two (5-1/2" x WOF) strips. Sub-cut thirteen 5-1/2" squares.

From 7175-33 Birds-Yellow:

*Cut two (4-7/8" x WOF) strips. Sub-cut twelve 4-7/8" squares. Cut once diagonally. (A)

From 7177-1 Mouse Plaid-White:

*Cut four (2-1/2" x WOF) strips. Sub-cut sixty 2-1/2" squares.

From 7175-17 Birds-Blue:

*Cut three (5-1/2" x WOF) strips. Sub-cut fifteen 5-1/2" squares.

From 7174-11 Black and White Cats-Sky Blue:

*Cut three (5-1/2" x WOF) strips. Sub-cut fifteen 5-1/2" squares.

From 7172-33 Allover Cats-Yellow:

*Cut three (4-7/8" x WOF) strips. Sub-cut eighteen 4-7/8" squares. Cut once diagonally. (B)

From 7176-99 Cat Whiskers-Black:

*Cut five (2-7/8" x WOF) strips. Sub-cut sixty 2-7/8" squares. Cut once diagonally. (C)

*Cut one (5-1/2" x WOF) strips. Sub-cut four 5-1/2" squares.

From 7170-11 Cat Blocks-Sky Blue:

*Cut fifteen (6-1/2") blocks.

From 7178-99 Paw Prints-Black:

*Cut two (5-1/2" x WOF) strips. Sub-cut thirteen 5-1/2" squares.

*Cut eight (2-1/2" x WOF) strips for binding.

From 7176-1 Cat Whiskers-White:

*Cut six (1-1/2" x WOF) strips for border 1.

*Cut nine (3" x WOF) strips. Sub-cut 120 3" squares.

From 7173-17 Border Stripe-Blue:

*Cut four (3" x **LOF**) strips for border 2 (black/white cats)

*Cut four (3-1/2" x **LOF**) strips for border 3 (flower/birds)

*Cut four (4-1/2" x **LOF**) strips for border 4 (sleeping cats/mice)

Assemble Blocks

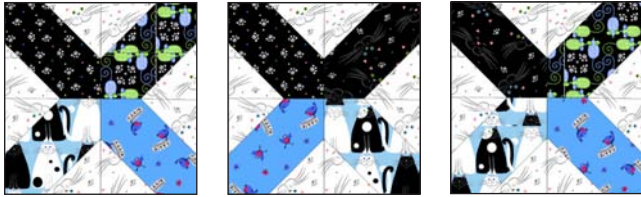
Note: Measurements include 1/4" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated. If no direction is specified, press seams toward darker fabric.

1. Sew a Cat Whiskers-White 3" square to two opposing corners of the Paw Prints-Black, Mouse Plaid-Black, Black and White Cats-Sky Blue, Birds-Blue, and Cat Whiskers-Black 5-1/2" squares. Trim and press open. (Figure 1).

2. Sew together four units from step 1 to make fifteen 10-1/2" blocks as follows (Figure 2, next page), noticing fabric orientation:

3. Sew two Cat Whiskers-Black triangles C to opposing sides of a 2-1/2" Mouse Plaid-White square (Figure 3). Press open. Repeat to make sixty units.

4. Sew two units from step 3 to opposing sides of a 6-1/2" Cat Blocks-Sky Blue block. Sew 2 more units to the remaining sides of the same block (Figure 4). Press open with seams toward center. Repeat to make fifteen block centers.

5. Pin and sew two Allover Cats-Yellow triangles B to opposing sides of a block center from step 4. Press open. Repeat with the other two sides (Figure 5). Make nine 10-1/2" blocks.

6. Repeat step 5 with the Birds-Yellow triangles A to make six 10-1/2" blocks (Figure 6).

Assemble Quilt Top

7. Lay out six rows of five alternating blocks as per quilt photo. Sew the rows together in order, matching seams. Press seams to one direction.

8. For border 1, sew six Mouse Plaid-White 1-1/2" border strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and cut 2 border 1 strips to this length. Sew strips to the sides of the quilt top. Measure the width of the quilt top through its center. Cut 2 border 1 strips to this length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press seams toward borders.

9. For border 2, mark the quilt center along the sides, top, and bottom. Sew together the four 3" strips of the Border Stripe-Blue (black/white cats) end to end with **straight** seams. Mark the center of each border strip. Matching the centers, sew each border strip in place beginning and ending exactly 1/4" from the corners. **DO NOT** trim the extra length.

10. To miter the borders, fold one corner of the quilt on a 45° angle so that the border strips are directly on top of one another and the seams nest together. Place rotary ruler on the fold of the quilt so that the long edge is against the fold and the 45° line is on the side of the seam. Draw a line from the corner of the quilt top to the outside edge of the border. Pin the borders together. Position your needle on the inside corner where the border meets the quilt. Stitch directly on the line you have drawn to the outside edge of the border. Trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press. Repeat the process for the remaining three corners of the quilt.

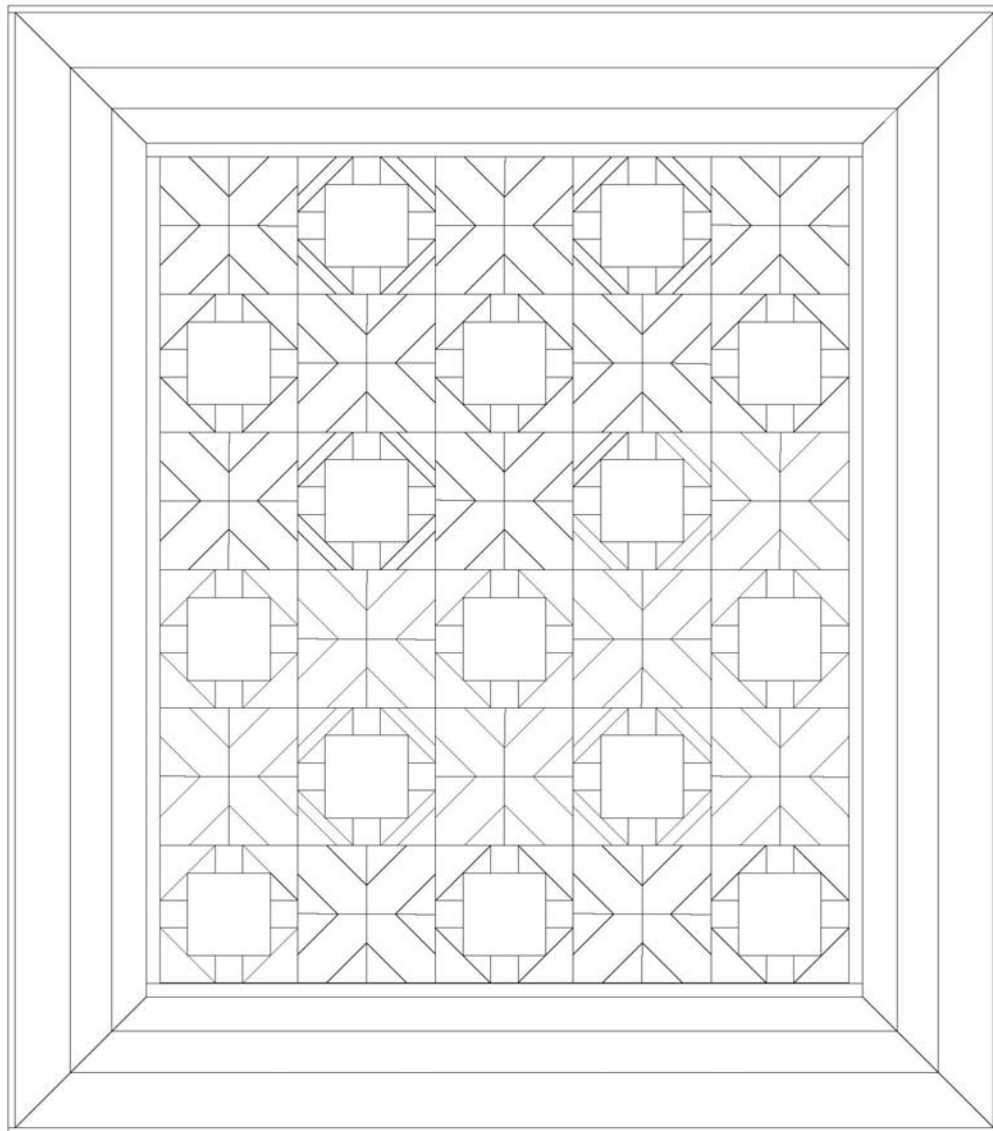
11. Repeat steps 9-10 with the four 3-1/2" strips of the Border Stripe-Blue (flower/birds) for border 3.

12. Repeat steps 9-10 with the four 4-1/2" strips of the Border Stripe-Blue (sleeping cats/mice) for border 4.

Finishing

13. Create a quilt sandwich with the batting between the quilt top and the backing. Pin or baste layers together, mark quilting design, and quilt by hand or machine. When quilting is complete, remove pins or basting, and trim batting and backing even with raw edges of the quilt top.

14. Join the eight Paw Prints-Black 2-1/2" binding strips together end to end using a diagonal seam to make one long strip. Press in half lengthwise. Sew binding to the edges of the quilt top, mitering corners, and overlapping ends. Fold binding to the back of the quilt and stitch it in place by hand to finish.
