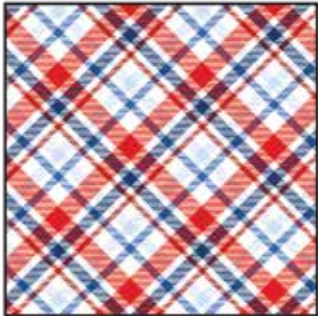

½ yard	Eagle Flag Toss - Red (F)	336-88
½ yard	Tossed Gnomes and Flags - Blue (G)	335-11
1 ⅞ yards	Novelty Gnome Stripe - Multi (H)	329-87
⅓ yard	Flag Hearts - Navy (I)	330-77
⅝ yard	Diagonal Stripe - Multi (J)	328-87*
4 ¾ yards	Patriotic Gnome Patchwork - Multi (Backing)	331-87

### Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the 24 Inch Panel - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 22 ½" x 40 ½" rectangle, centered on the panel.

#### From the Bias Plaid - Multi (B), cut:

- (2) 3" x 40 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 3" x 27 ½" WOF strips.

#### From the Folio Basics - True Red (C), cut:

- (3) 2 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 2 ⅞" squares.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 44 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 28 ½" WOF strips.

#### From the Stars - Navy (D), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (15) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Folio - White on White (E), cut:

- (3) 2 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 2 ⅞" squares.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (60) 2 ½" squares.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 46 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 30 ½" WOF strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 60 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 44 ½" strips.

#### From the Eagle Flag Toss - Red (F), cut:

- (2) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 6 ½" squares.

#### From the Tossed Gnomes and Flags - Blue (G), cut:

- (2) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (7) 6 ½" squares.

#### From the Novelty Gnome Stripe - Multi (H), fussy cut:

- (2) 7 ¼" x 62 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips, centered on white and red stripes.
- (2) 7 ¼" x 44 ½" LOF strips, centered on white and red stripes.

#### From the Flag Hearts - Navy (I), cut:

- (1) 7 ¼" x OF strip. Sub-cut (4) 7 ¼" squares.

#### From the Diagonal Stripe - Multi (J), cut:

- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

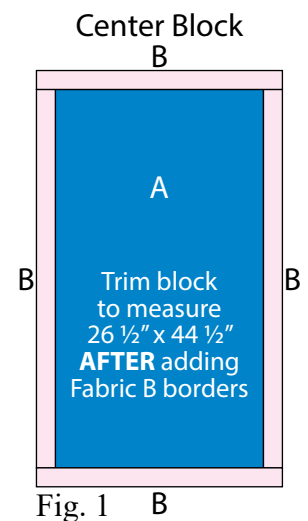
#### From the Patriotic Gnome Patchwork - Multi (Backing), cut:

- (2) 84" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 66" x 84" back.

### Block Assembly

*Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.*

1. Sew (1) 3" x 40 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 3" x 27 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 26 ½" x 44 ½"**.



2. Place (1) 2 ⅞" Fabric E square on top of (1) 2 ⅞" Fabric C square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 2). Sew ¼" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 3) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2 ½" (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (60) Unit 1 squares total.

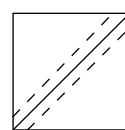

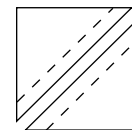

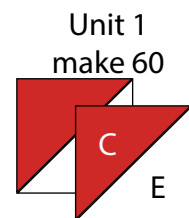

# GNOME OF THE BRAVE Quilt 1

3. Sew (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square to each side of (1) Unit 1 square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each side of (1) 2 ½" Fabric D square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 6 ½" Block One square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (15) Block One squares total.

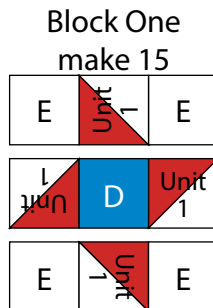
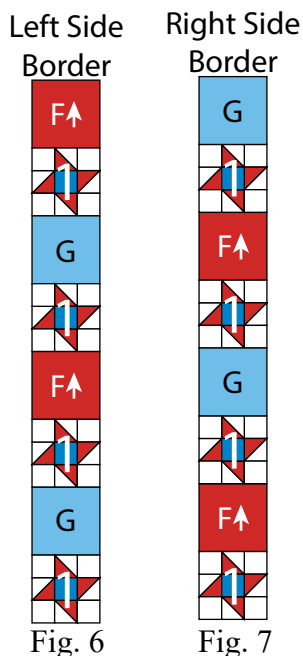


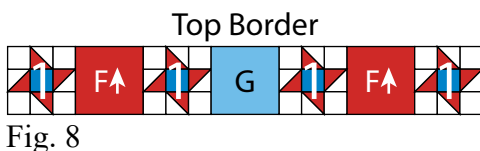

4. Refer to Figure 6 and sew together (2) 6 ½" Fabric F squares, (4) Block One squares and (2) 6 ½" Fabric G squares to make the Left Side Border.

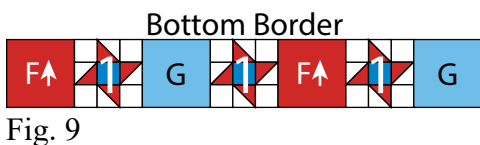


5. Refer to Figure 7 and sew together (2) 6 ½" Fabric G squares, (4) Block One squares and (2) 6 ½" Fabric F squares to make the Right Side Border.

6. Refer to Figure 8 and sew together (4) Block One squares, (2) 6 ½" Fabric F squares and (1) 6 ½" Fabric G square to make the Top Border.



7. Refer to Figure 9 and sew together (2) 6 ½" Fabric F squares, (3) Block One squares and (2) 6 ½" Fabric G squares to make the Bottom Border.



### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

8. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 28 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

9. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 46 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 30 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

10. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.

11. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

12. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 60 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

13. Sew (1) 7 ¼" x 62 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block.

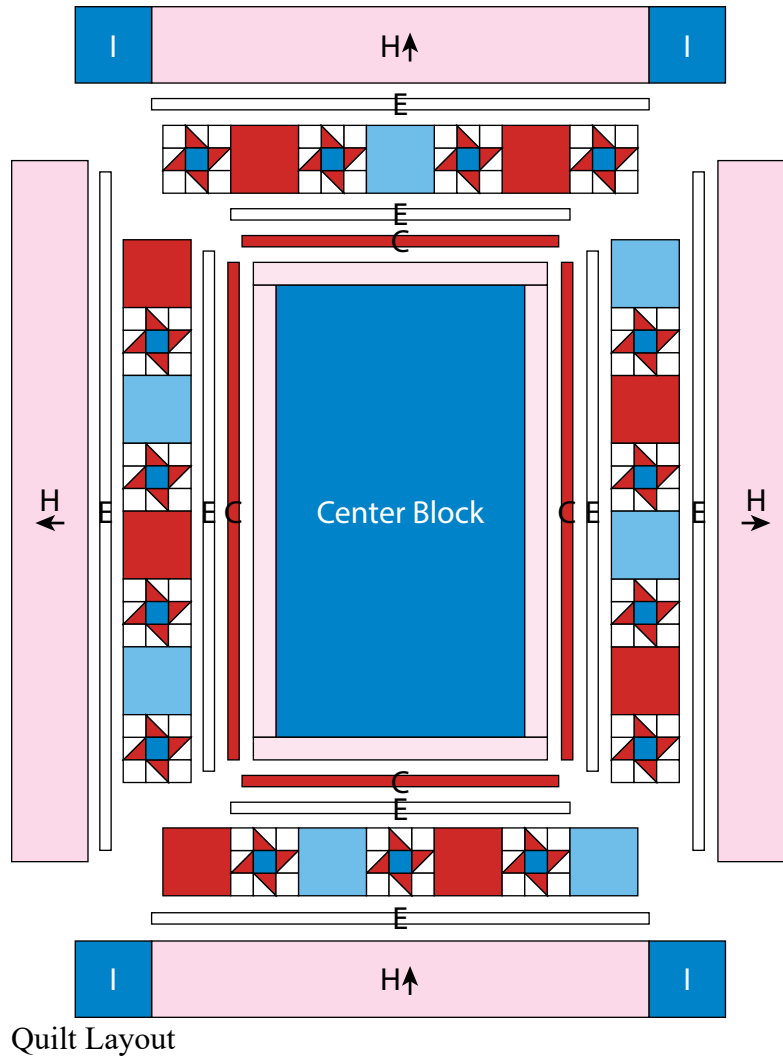
14. Sew (1) 7 ¼" Fabric I square to each end of (1) 7 ¼" x 44 ½" Fabric H strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

15. Layer and quilt as desired.

16. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric J strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

17. Bind as desired.

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
