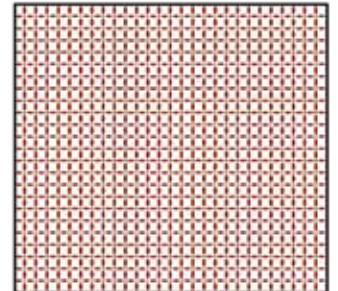

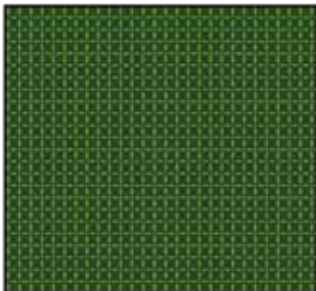

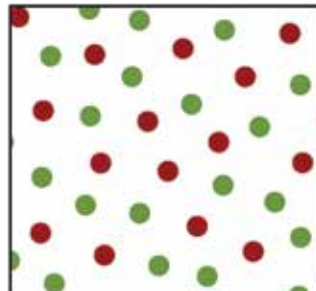

# HOLLY HILL CHRISTMAS

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## Materials

1 panel	Holly Hill Christmas Panel - Red (A)	2478P-88
5/8 yard	Circles - Green (B)	2483-66*
5/8 yard	Tossed Houses - Green (C)	2482-66
1 1/4 yards	Tossed Houses - White (Backing)	2482-18

\*Includes binding

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

### From the Holly Hill Christmas Panel - Red (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 21 1/2" x 27" panel centered on the house.

### From the Circles - Green (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 27" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 24 1/2" WOF strips.
- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

### From the Tossed Houses - Green (C), cut:

- (2) 4" x 30" WOF strips.
- (2) 4" x 31 1/2" WOF strips.

### From the Tossed Houses - White (Backing), cut:

- (1) 39" x 44" LOF strip for the backing.

## Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) 2" x 27" Fabric B strip to each side of the 21 1/2" x 27" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x 24 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

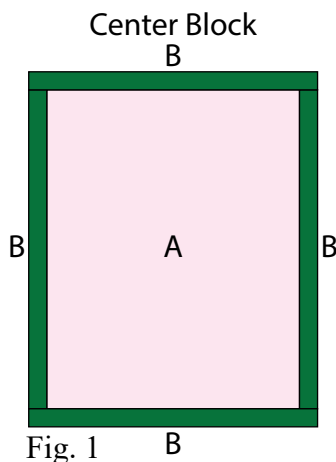
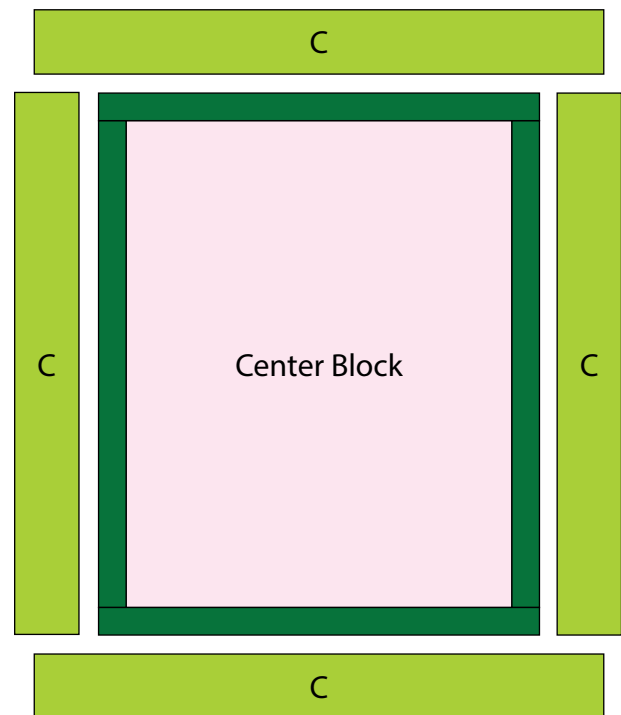

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

2. Sew (1) 4" x 30" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4" x 31 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
3. Layer and quilt as desired.
4. Sew the (4) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
5. Bind as desired.
